Appian Global Dividend Growth Fund

The Appian Global Dividend Growth Fund (the Fund) is an actively managed, concentrated global equity fund that invests in guality large-cap companies at attractive valuations. We believe this is the path to achieving long-term superior risk adjusted returns.

We define quality within equities as the ability to generate excellent returns on capital and turn these returns into cash. The ability to generate high levels of returns and translate these returns into cash allows companies to return cash to shareholders in the form of dividends and invest in the business thereby driving long-term dividend growth and ultimately share prices.

All our investment decisions are driven by valuation and this comes through in the companies in the Fund having an average dividend yield in excess of the market and a price to earnings ratio which is lower than the market.
