
The Gresham House Global Thematic Multi Asset Fund (the Fund) is a multi-asset fund which follows a similar investment strategy to the Gresham House Global Multi-Asset Fund. It differentiates itself by applying ethical exclusions and a thematic focus. The Fund is diversified and invests in a comprehensive range of traditional and alternative asset classes. This includes equities, fixed income, property, infrastructure, venture capital, commodities, forestry and currencies.

Fund objective

The investment objective of the Fund is to achieve long-term capital appreciation with moderate risk exposure.

The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing on a diversified basis in transferable securities, such as equity securities and debt securities, and in collective investment schemes. The Fund may invest across asset classes, sectors, geographies, and market capitalisations without limitation save in respect of the restriction on investment in collective investment schemes described below.

The Fund is classified as a financial product which promotes environmental and/or social characteristics as described in Article 8 of EU Sustainable Finance Disclosures Regulation (2019/2088) on sustainabilityrelated disclosures in the financial services sector (SFDR).




