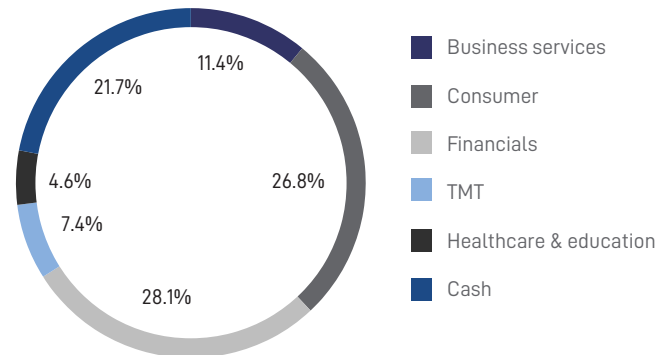

Sector allocation

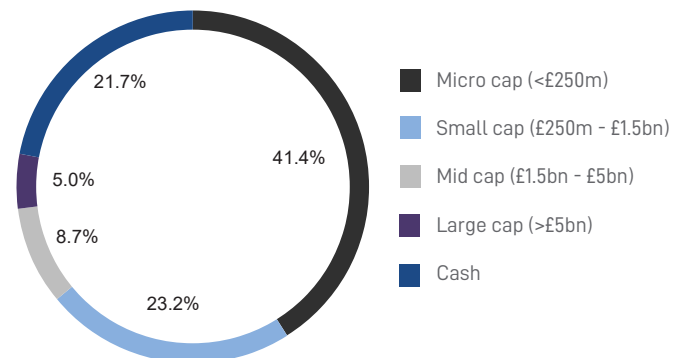
