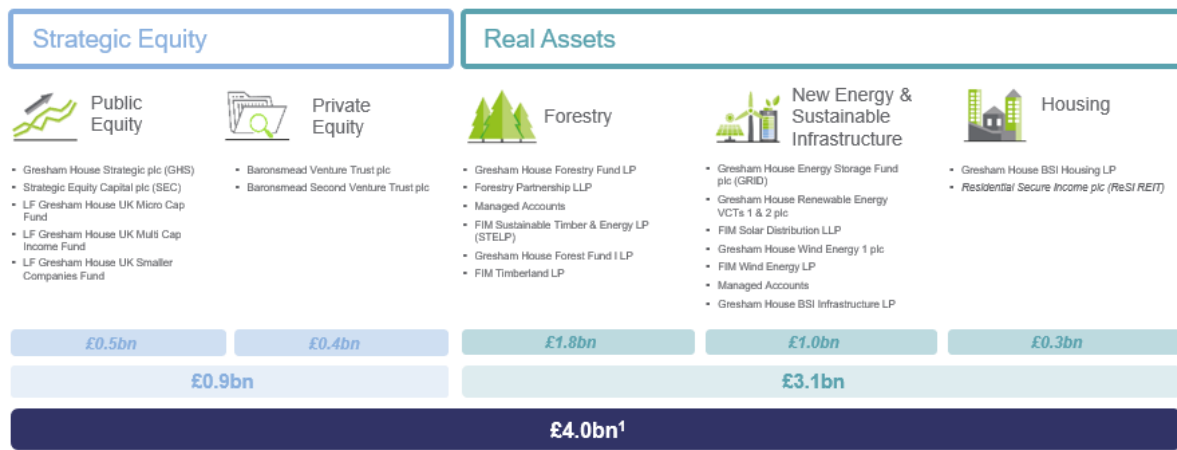

Business Overview

From a standing start in December 2014, through a combination of acquisitions and organic growth, the Gresham House business has grown exponentially, with assets under management now at c.£4.0 billion, (31 December 2020), providing a strong and scalable platform from which to continue to grow. Role Objective

The New Energy division supports the shift from a world powered by finite resources to a new energy world powered by renewables, while generating sustainable long-term returns. The team invests in the rapidly changing energy landscape, despite regulatory uncertainty and complex risks.

Investments are focused on four transformative technologies: solar, wind, energy storage and electric transportation. Returns are supported by strong asset backing, a sustainable income yield and the potential for capital growth.

Key Responsibilities / Accountabilities

- Ongoing compliance with commercial operational obligations (legal, warranty, business plan, , environmental, H&S, etc.).
- Ad-hoc project support (typical projects are expected to include setup of new management systems, construction projects, new revenue opportunities, and re-optimisation of the operational fleet).
- Management of optimisation counterparties and market monitoring across multiple revenue streams.
- Monthly call with O&M to ensure best performance of Solar, Wind and Battery assets
- Qualify assets under the different Nationalgrideso auctions like CM, DC, etc.
- To be Gresham House representative for Optimizers and National Grid
- Front office – bidding for various services and finalising on contracts.
- Back office – settlement of revenues, contract revenues with NG, imbalance with suppliers, embedded benefits etc. and liaison with finance team.
- Contract management and asset management, including:
 - O&M contract management, mainly in operational phase.
 - Managing multiple revenue streams and reconciliations.
 - Trading contract management, linked into commercial operations above.
 - Direct services (or management of same via O&M contracts).
 - Other services/payments, e.g. insurance, rates, rent etc. Some functions are currently split between Oxford and London teams, and the role is to ensure better integration between teams and locations.
- Regulatory management – for example new revenue streams, flexibility service tenders, regulatory changes and developments.
- This role is mainly office based, but travel may be required to customer, supplier or service partner locations (approximately 1 day per month).
- The base location for this role can be either London or Oxford, travel to the other location may be required approximately 1 day per month.

Skills & Experience

- Deep knowledge of the UK electricity market will be an advantage
- Numerical degree, technical, financial or science background. Suitable candidates with an IT/data science will also be considered.
- Energy industry (renewable assets, fossil fuelled assets, or utility environment) experience.
- The ability to provide in-depth analysis.
- Medium-advanced user of general office systems, business information & management systems will be beneficial.
- Strong interpersonal skills as the role intersects with a broad cross-section of the business (e.g. from fund reporting activities, to management of site operations / optimisation teams).
