**Location:** The Pales is located approximately 1.3 miles west of the village of Llanddowror within

3 miles of the town of St Clears, in Carmarthenshire.

**Volumes:** The tonnage has been estimated by the woodland manager. The volumes are only

estimates and prospective purchasers are deemed to have satisfied themselves as to

their accuracy.

Access, Extraction and Stacking:

Access routes are shown on the attached maps. The forest road will be upgraded by the seller in advance of harvesting. It is expected that any additional stacking facilities such as benches or ramps are installed at the purchaser's expense. Damage to the forest road is to be kept to a minimum, and any damage caused by machinery running on the road, will be repaired at the purchaser's expense.

**Hazards:** Hazards are detailed on the attached plan.

Reporting: The purchaser is required to report monthly to GHAM and a copy of the report

template is available on request. The report will require the date, delivery number and tonnes of each load in a spreadsheet format. GHAM will expect to be able to obtain

copies of all weight tickets at any point during the contract.

Felling: All conifers in the sale area should be felled unless instructed by the Woodland

Manager. All material above 5cm diameter is to be removed from the site by the

purchaser.

**Brash:** Brash is to be kept clear of all watercourses during the felling operations. Purchasers

should state their proposals for leaving the site clear and ready for replanting following discussion with the Woodland Manager and brash should be cut into lengths of less

than 2 metres.

Urea: N/A

Payment: Payment terms are to be on a monthly basis with the purchaser producing self billing

invoices based on weight tickets, or as otherwise agreed between the parties.

A down payment may be payable before entry and offset against the penultimate

payment, or as otherwise agreed between the parties.

**Contract:** An Agreement will be required to be signed by both parties. A copy is available on

request.

Although the vendor intends to sell the timber, the vendor will not be bound to accept

the highest or any other offer.

**Viewing:** The timber may be viewed at any reasonable time during daylight hours, as long as a

copy of this document is carried.

The gate code for the woodland entrance is 0621.
